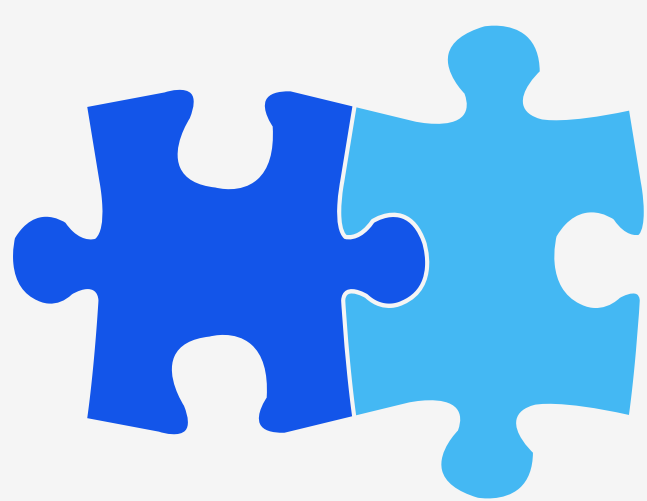

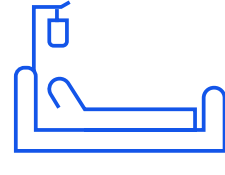

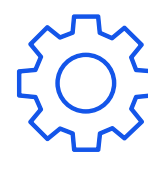

Misconceptions about specialty pharmacy management can result in lost dollars. Here's what the data shows.



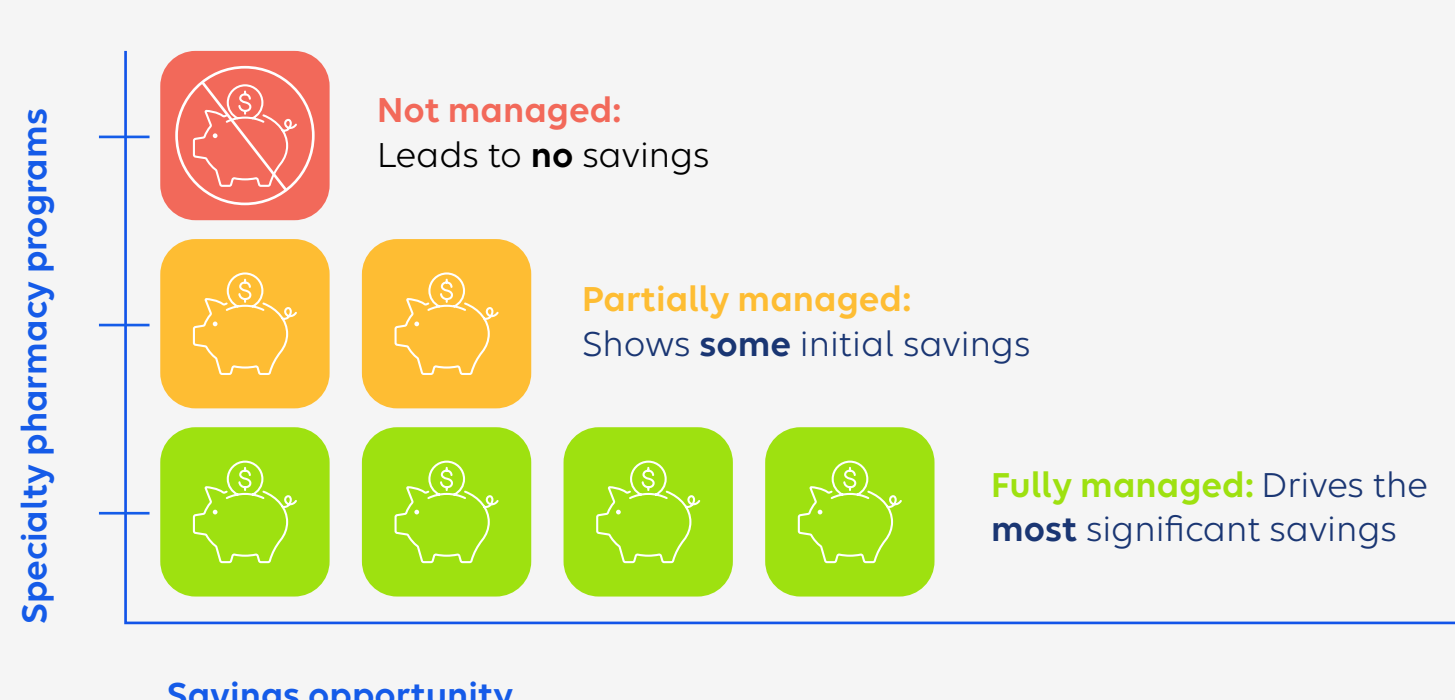
### Myth
